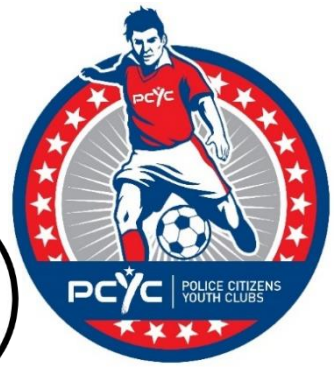

HOW TO REGISTER

- You can register as a Team or to join a Team online via SportFix <https://sportfix.net/PCYCFarSouthCoast>
- All players must be current PCYC members, this can be completed via our website or this link: <https://secure.activecarrot.com/public/contract/application/575/730> if you are unsure if you have a current membership or not, please contact PCYC to confirm farsouthcoast@pcycnsw.org.au or 0482 161 306.

SEASON DATES/TIMES

PCYC Far South Coast will operate a 10-week Winter season competition, which will commence in May. Games will run between 5.30pm – 6:45pm, with time slots subject to demand. While every effort will be made to accommodate time preferences, no guarantees can be made. All teams will be given an even spread of game times (early and late games) throughout the season.

TEAM COMPETITION FEES

Season Fees: \$540 includes match fees, individual player registration for up to 6 players. All fees are due 7 days prior to first game. If fees are an issue, please email farsouthcoast@pcycnsw.org.au to work out a payment plan. As an individual; you can express your interest with staff and be allocated to a team.

All players must be PCYC members.

TEAMS AND PLAYERS

Each team is to register a minimum of 6 players per team. Players must be 16 years of age and over to play in senior competitions.

IMPORTANT: Each person can only register in one team per day (irrespective of the number of divisions).

TEAM DELEGATE

A primary contact (team delegate) must be nominated when registering a team on SportFix. In the event of a forfeit or any correspondence, the team delegate will be contacted by the PCYC. It will be the responsibility of the delegate to pass all correspondence onto their team.

GAME DURATION

- Senior games are 2 x 22 minute halves.

FIXTURES

- PCYC competitions use SportFix online to log all competition game times, divisions & results.

UNIFORMS

- Teams are responsible for all their players in each team to wear uniform/matching-coloured shirts or playing strips.
- Fluro Goal-keeper bibs will be available.

BORROWING PLAYERS

A team may only borrow a maximum of 1 registered player under the following circumstances:

1. Each team must have a minimum of 6 players to take the field, if a team is short a player, borrowing players from the same or a lower division is permitted.
2. Borrowed players must be current registered PCYC members.

RULES:

Football NSW rules are played and adhered to by the Umpires officiating.

1. Slide-tackling and contact-tackling-from-behind is **highly discouraged** and will forfeit to an open-goal penalty from the quarter field mark (no defenders, no goalie)
2. No 'throw-ins'. The ball is kicked-in to play from the boundary line and is afforded 3m space to do so. Kick-ins must not be pitched higher than the knee.
3. No offside rule - but players should not hang right by the goal or otherwise take unfair advantage.
4. Handballs and other minor fouls result in an Indirect Penalty (defenders permitted).
5. Own-team pass-backs to goalies will result in an Indirect Penalty from the quarter field mark.
6. All goal kicks to be put back into play from the ground only.

PENALTIES:

Suspensions can apply for off the court incidents at the location; you are responsible for your actions and behaviour at all times.

CHALLENGES

Any challenges made by a team towards another team i.e. suspected unregistered players playing or other match disputes must be done through competition staff as soon as possible, preferably at the start of the game.

COMPLAINTS PROCEDURE:

Teams that wish to lodge a complaint must do so in writing to farsouthcoast@pcycnsw.org.au. Please be aware that this is the correct process for lodging complaints or concerns. Teams and players that confront staff, other players or match officials will face suspension or even expulsion from the competition.
