COMPETITION DETAILS

It is a requirement that ALL players participating in any PCYC Hornsby indoor competition must be current financial PCYC members. Membership completed [Online](#)

PCYC Hornsby offers U10s, U12s & U14s competitions each term.
The competitions run for 10 weeks – 9 rounds, 1 week finals.

HOW TO REGISTER

- Team Delegate to fill out team nomination form and hand in/emailed to PCYC Hornsby
PLEASE NOTE THAT NO FIXTURES WILL BE ALLOCATED UNTIL PCYC HAS RECEIVED YOUR TEAMSHEET
- All players must be PCYC members. Annual membership is \$15.00 and must be completed before taking part in any games.
- *Submit team nomination form via email to hornsbyscomps@pcycnsw.org.au*

Team registration sheets including ALL player details must be completed upon registration. PCYC Hornsby will not roll over registration forms from previous seasons. Only players who appear on the team sheet will be eligible to play. Team delegates are responsible for updating player details and adding or removing players from team lists during season.

You may join the competition as a team, individual, or group of friends – we will try and place groups in a team together where possible. Preference will be given to existing players.

PLAYER FEES

Player Fees are payable by the start of the competition. Breakdown:

- Each player must register individually. Player fee is \$135.00 per player
- Price includes Match fees & Individual Player Registration fees
- ALL players must have a current PCYC Membership
- Team members submitted on the Registration Form must play a minimum of 4 games to be eligible for Finals
- Upon registration players commit to the code of conduct outlined in this package.

COMPETITION DETAILS & REQUIREMENTS

PLAYER ELIGIBILITY

- A maximum of eight (8) registered players in a team.
- Teams must have 4 of their listed team playing in order for the game to count for competition points.
- If a team has less than 4 players then the game will be played but the score will be recorded as 20-0 in favor of the opposition.
- Players from Division 1 cannot fill-in for a Division 2 game, if a Division 1 player plays in a Division 2 game then the game is declared a forfeit.

TEAM DELEGATE

The nominated team delegates are responsible to pass on all correspondence to their team members and to complete the team nomination form with all correct contact details requested. In the event of a forfeit or any other correspondence, the team delegates will be contacted by PCYC.

SIGN ON

- All players must 'sign on' on the score sheet **before** taking the court.
- A minimum of 4 registered members of the team **MUST** sign on before the game can start.
- Sub/borrowed players must print and sign their names at the bottom of the sheet.

GAME DURATION

- U10s are 2 x 14 minute halves
- U12s & U14s are 2 x 18 minute halves
- Teams will lose 2 points for every minute they are late. The game is declared a forfeit if less than 4 players are present 10 minutes after allocated game time.
- Running clock (at no point should the clock be stopped during the game, there are no timeouts. During Finals, the clock will be stopped within the last minute if the score is within 5 points when the ball goes out or during subbing/free throws.

U10s MODIFIED RULES

U10s is perfect for those who are very new to basketball; the ref teaches the rules and coaches while controlling the game.

The ref may introduce modified rules throughout the term to develop players skills, promote e.g. of modifications below:

- **Man-on-Man defence:** Each player will be given a coloured wrist band and they must defend the player on the other team with the same colour i.e. red wrist band.
(Team A, marks red wrist band of Team B)
- **Three dribble only:** Player must pass to a teammate after three bounces.
- **Mercy rule, 5 pass, Shoot outside of the key rules:** As below

MERCY RULE

A mercy rule is a defensive restriction, helping to promote sportsmanship.

The defensive team will be required to drop back to within the 3pt line when they leading by 20+ points or more (U12s & U14s) and 15+ points or more (U10s).

5 passes is an offensive restriction helping to promote sportsmanship & team inclusion.

Once over half court the offensive team leading by 30+ points (U12's) , will be required to pass the ball to every team member before they score.

20+ points (U10s).

Shooting outside of the key is an offensive restriction helping to promote sportsmanship and encourages teams leading by 35+ points (U12's) to develop their mid- long range shooting skills.

The offensive team can only shoot from outside of the key way.

25+ points (U10s).

BENCH DUTY

Each team must provide one parent to score their teams game. Teams listed **ABOVE** on the Sportfix App (or on the **LEFT HANDSIDE** on the scoresheet) are responsible for supplying a scorer 15 years and over for that match. Disputes concerning the score will not be entered in to if your team is unable to provide a suitable scorer.

SIGN ON

All players must scan their PCYC membership card upon entering the courts.
They must also take a bib and write the number next to their name on the score sheet.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- ALL participants MUST be a current PCYC Member
- NO MEMBERSHIP CARD = NO ENTRY! Recommended taking a photo of the barcode on the card and store in your phone or preferred card storage app. \$5 replacement card.
- You are required to participate in a sportsmanlike manner, with respect for the umpire and opposition at all times
- Conduct yourself in a responsible manner relating to language, temper and punctuality. Do not use profane language at any time.
- At no time can a player abuse, insult or criticise any umpire, opponent or staff member
- Staff and officials reserve the right to remove any player/s not abiding by these conditions
- At no time will person/s on the sideline (ie supporters, players on the bench) address the umpire or player/s in an unsportsmanlike manner – anyone seen to be abusing players and/or officials on court will be asked to leave the premises immediately.
- Abide by the rules and respect the decision of the umpires. Be courteous and use the correct process when seeking a rule clarification.

STANDINGS – COMPETITION POINTS

Win = 3points Draw/BYE = 2 points Loss = 1 point Forfeit (Giving) = 0 point

FINALS SERIES

Play Off's are played on the last week of Term with a format as follows:

- Major Final - 1st v 2nd
- Play Off – 3rd v 4th
- Times for the games of the final's series will be confirmed and teams will be notified.
To be eligible for finals a player must have played in the team at least 4 times over the course of the season.

UNIFORMS

- PCYC Hornsby can provide bibs when required
- Each player must be wearing suitable footwear to take the court- this means no sandals or other footwear that may be considered dangerous.
- Fingernails are to satisfaction of the umpire
- PCYC Hornsby requires all jewellery removed

INJURIES

The player or team involved at the time of the incident, or immediately following the game must report all injuries. If injuries are not reported within 24 hours, PCYC will not be held liable.

BLOOD RULE

All blood stoppages will be 30 seconds, and the injured player must come off the court. If there is blood on bibs and/or clothing, it must be removed and replaced for safety and hygiene.

COMPLAINTS / CHALLENGES PROCEDURE

Teams wishing to lodge a complaint must do so in writing via email. We request this is done within 3 working days. Any challenges made by a team towards another team or player must be done through the competition staff as soon as possible; preferably during breaks or at the end of the game.

WARNINGS/SUSPENSIONS

In the event of three (3) accumulated warnings, suspension awarded at the discretion of PCYC management. Suspensions can apply for all on/off court incidents at PCYC; *you* are responsible for your own actions and behaviour at all times. Team Delegates will be notified on the final decision via email. Suspensions are determined by Management and are final.

PREGNANCY

Player plays at own risk. We recommend participants seek guidance from their GP.
