CITIZENSHIP

COMPETITION DETAILS

It is a requirement that <u>ALL</u> players participating in any PCYC Hornsby indoor competition must be current financial PCYC members. Membership completed <u>online.</u>

HOW TO REGISTER

- Team Delegate to fill out team nomination form and hand in/emailed to PCYC Hornsby PLEASE NOTE THAT NO FIXTURES WILL BE ALLOCATED UNTIL PCYC HAS RECEIVED YOUR TEAMSHEET
- All players must be PCYC members. Annual membership is \$30.00 and must be completed before taking part in any games.
- Submit team nomination form via email to hornsbycomps@pcycnsw.org.au

Team registration sheets including ALL player details must be completed upon registration. PCYC Hornsby will not roll over registration forms from previous seasons. Only players who appear on the team sheet will be eligible to play. Team captains are responsible for updating player details and adding or removing players from team lists during season.

TEAM FEES

Team Fees are payable by the start of the competition. Breakdown:

- i. \$220 per player
- ii. Price includes Match fees, Individual Player Registration fees & 1 set of bibs to keep (As part of our covid safe plan to ensure teams are not sharing bibs. All New teams registered will receive a set of bibs at the commencement of the season).
- iii. ALL players must have a current PCYC Membership
- iv. All teams must have a minimum of 7 players registered in the team to take the court
- v. Team members submitted on the Registration Form must play a minimum of 5 games to be eligible for Finals
- vi. Upon registration players commit to the code of conduct outlined in this package.

COMPETITION DETAILS & REQUIREMENTS

PLAYER ELIGIBILITY

- 14 years of age for all Ladies comps (as per Netball NSW guidelines)
- Extenuating circumstances granted to under the ages as stated above at the discretion of management. If accepted, a waiver is required to be signed
- Players can register in all our netball competitions, however, cannot register in a second team in the one competition.

TEAM DELEGATE

The nominated team delegates are responsible to pass on all correspondence to their team members and to complete the team nomination form with all correct contact details requested. In the event of a forfeit or any other correspondence, the team delegates will be contacted by PCYC.

SIGN ON

- <u>All</u> players must 'sign on' on the score sheet **before** taking the court.
- A minimum of 5 registered members of the team MUST sign on before the game can start.
- Sub/borrowed players must print and sign their names at the bottom of the sheet.

SUB / BORROWED PLAYERS

- Must play in WING positions
- Each team must have a minimum of five (5) registered players take to the court. If your team is down to this number, you must seek out only two (2) more players.
- A player cannot sub more than 3 games. Prior to their 4th game they must become a member of the team and pay the appropriate fees.
- Borrowing players from the same or lower divisions is permitted e.g. Division 2 players can play in Division 1 or for another Division 2 team, but cannot play in Division 3
- NB: If teams are caught with illega<mark>l fill-ins, the team</mark> risk having points deducted
- Be current registered PCYC members and are required to write their names on the score sheet at the bottom.
- If your team has players, running late, and you have (5) or (6), you can still take to the court you really do not require a sub for this reason alone. However, should you though organise a sub to fill in until your player/s arrive, the sub player/s must leave the court for the registered player to commence immediately on arrival, and are not to be rotated on again. Failure to acknowledge this rule will result in points deducted.
- Players not on the original team list <u>CANNOT</u> be borrowed for Finals irrespective of how many times they have filled in We ask that when using a replacement player that you please bear in mind the calibre of the player and the Division they are playing in

FORFEITS

A team that wishes to Forfeit a game MUST have the team delegate contact PCYC by phoning 8998 5400 and speak to a staff member or send a txt message to 0491 697 203 by at least Midday on the day of competition

- A **\$100 forfeit fee <u>may</u>** be applied should the forfeit call be made after this time on a reoccurring basis.
- If a game is forfeited the opposing team will be notified via a phone call as soon as possible.
- Teams in later time slots may be contacted in relation to moving their game times forward where possible.
- If a team is unable to take the court at the time of their game due to players running late or being away, they will be given 5 minutes after the time the game is meant to commence to find enough players (5 players from the original team) to start the game. If this cannot be done it will be up to the umpires and officials whether the game is forfeited.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- ALL participants MUST be a current PCYC Member
- NO MEMBERSHIP CARD = NO ENTRY! Recommended taking a photo of the barcode on the card and store in your phone or preferred card storage app. \$5 replacement card.
- You are required to participate in a sportsmanlike manner, with respect for the umpire and opposition at all times
- Conduct yourself in a responsible manner relating to language, temper and punctuality. Do not use profane language at any time.
- At no time can a player abuse, insult or criticise any umpire, opponent or staff member
- Staff and officials reserve the right to remove any player/s not abiding by these conditions
- At no time will person/s on the sideline (ie supporters, players on the bench) address the umpire or player/s in an unsportsmanlike manner anyone seen to be abusing players and/or officials on court will be asked to leave the premises immediately.
- Abide by the rules and respect the decision of the umpires. Be courteous and use the correct process when seeking a rule clarification.

GAME DURATION

- 45 minutes - 4 x 10 minute quarters, 1 min breaks, with running clock for all games.

RESULTS & FIXTURES

SCORING

Teams listed <u>ABOVE</u> on the Sportfix App (or on the <u>LEFT HANDSIDE</u> on the scoresheet) are responsible for supplying a scorer 15 years and over for that match. Disputes concerning the score will not be entered in to if your team is unable to provide a suitable scorer.

FINALS SERIES

Finals is played over the course of one night with a format as follows:

- Semi Final 1 1st v 4th (winner proceeds to grand final)
- Semi Final 2 2nd v 3rd (winner proceeds to Grand final)
- Grand Final; winners from both semi finals

-The two semi-final games in the final's series will consist of four 6 minute quarters (24 minute games) -The grand final game will consist of the regular 4 x 10 minute quarters.

-Times for the games of the final's series will be confirmed and teams will be notified.

To be eligible for finals a player must have played in the team at least 5 times over the course of the season.

UNIFORMS

- All New registered teams will receive bibs either upon registration or on the commencement of their first game.
- Each player must be wearing suitable footwear to take the court- this means no sandals or other footwear that may be considered dangerous.
- Fingernails are to satisfaction of the umpire; PCYC Hornsby allows taping of nails or gloves, however, prefer all players have their nails cut short. Again, it is the players responsibility to provide tape and gloves.
- PCYC Hornsby requires all jewellery removed however, we understand some items cannot. In this instance, it
 is the players responsibility to provide tape. PCYC Hornsby notes players that choose to tape jewellery play
 at their own risk.

RULES

Australia Netball Association Rules are played and adhered to by the accredited Umpires officiating. Any questions or concerns about rules can be discussed with the umpire at the time or emailed following the complaint process listed.

INJURIES

The player or team involved at the time of the incid<mark>ent, or immed</mark>iately following the game must report all injuries. If injuries are not reported within 24 hours, PCYC will not be held liable.

BLOOD RULE (as per Rules of Netball - Netball Australia)

All blood stoppages will be 30 seconds, and the injured player must come off the court. If there is blood on bibs and/or clothing, it must be removed and replaced for safety and hygiene.

COMPLAINTS / CHALLENGES PROCEDURE

Teams wishing to lodge a complaint must do so in writing via email. We request this is done within 3 working days. Any challenges made by a team towards another team or player must be done through the competition staff as soon as possible; preferably during breaks or at the end of the game.

WARNINGS/SUSPENSIONS

In the event of three (3) accumulated warnings, suspension awarded at the discretion of PCYC management. Suspensions can apply for all on/off court incidents at PCYC; *you* are responsible for your own actions and behaviour at all times. Team Delegates will be notified on the final decision via email. Suspensions are determined by Management and are final.

PREGNANCY

Player plays at own risk. We recommend participants seek guidance from their GP.
