TEAM REGISTRATION

OPENS Monday 15 March 2021; CLOSES 5pm Fri 26 March 2021 – unless at capacity prior.

It is a requirement that <u>ALL</u> players participating in any PCYC Northern Beaches indoor competition must be current financial PCYC members. Membership completed <u>online</u>.

MIXED MONDAY EVENING

(NB: Divisions dependent on amount of registered teams). Eg:

- I. **Pool A** Competitive. Suitable for teams with skilled players.
- II. **Pool B** Social is for those players who enjoy their netball but are not so serious. Your team may be a broad cross section of ages and of varying abilities and experience. The focus of this division is on fun and friendship.

NB: Week 3 or 4, Divisions *may* be re-graded to create a more competitive competition for that division.

LADIES WEDNSEDAY EVENING

(NB: Divisions and which evenings teams play is dependent on amount of registered teams). Eq:

- **Division 1** Competitive. Suitable skilled teams who play together in their local competition.
- II. Division 2 Intermediate. Suitable for those players of various abilities who come together to form a team to keep their netball skills fresh.
- III. Division 3 Social. For players who enjoy their netball but are not so serious, and are of varying abilities and experience.

TEAM FEES

Breakdown:

- i. \$1000 per team (based on 10 players) includes \$80 weekly team fee + Individual Player Registration fee
- ii. ALL players must have a current PCYC Membership
- **iii.** Team members submitted on the Registration Form must play a minimum of 5 games to be eligible for Finals
- iv. Signed Team Form to be completed by the Team Delegate

ACTIVE KIDS VOUCHER

- I. All vouchers must be attached to the team list at the time of registration submission
- II. Please ensure Membership details match the voucher ie DOB, mobile and email
- III. Vouchers will not be accepted after the team fee has been received and paid in full

HOW TO REGISTER

We have gone digital! Please email the NB PCYC netball coordinator Miriam French – mfrench@pcycnsw.org.au – to request the online registration link. Please follow the following steps:

- Team Delegate enter team details, as well as all competing player details: FULL NAME + PCYC CARD NUMBER
- 2. **Netball Coordinator** confirms via email to team delegate with confirmation of comp entry plus next steps i.e. team payment details and any outstanding or new memberships
- 3. **Team fees** a due date will be provided; we cannot guarantee your spot if fees are not paid on time

COMPETITION DETAILS

PLAYER ELLIGIBILITY

- MIXED has a minimum of 1 male or a maximum of 3 males on court in each third:
- 16 years of age for Mixed; 14 years of age for all Ladies comps (as per Netball NSW guidelines)
- Extenuating circumstances granted to under the ages as stated above at the discretion of management. If accepted, a waiver is required to be signed
- Players can register in all of our netball competitions however cannot register in a second team in the one comp.

TEAM DELEGATE

The nominated team delegate is responsible to complete the team submission with all correct contact details required and pass on all correspondence to their team members and. In the event of a forfeit or any other correspondence, the team delegate will be contacted by the PCYC.

SIGN ON

- All players must 'sign on' on the score sheet before taking to the court
- A minimum of 5 registered members of the team MUST sign on before the game can start
- Sub / borrowed players must print and sign their names at the bottom of the sheet
- Team Delegates are required to check and enter the score, and sign the score sheet

SUB / BORROWED PLAYERS

- Must play in WING positions in the first instance
- Each team must have a minimum of five (5) registered players take to the court. If your team is down to this number, you must seek out only two (2) more players.
- Borrowing players from the same or lower divisions is permitted e.g. Division 2 players can play in Division 1 or for another Division 2 team, but cannot play in Division 3
- NB: If teams are caught with illegal fill-ins, the team risk having points deducted
- Be current registered PCYC members and are required to write their names on the score sheet under the SUBS section.
- Be identified to the Umpire indicating which team they are playing for failure to do so may result in points deducted
- If your team has players, running late, and you have (5) or (6), you can still take to the court you do not require a sub for this reason alone. However, should you though organise a sub to fill in until your player/s arrive, the sub player/s *must* leave the court at the next Centre pass for the registered player to commence immediately on arrival, and are *not* to be rotated on again. Failure to acknowledge this rule will result in points deducted.
- Players not on the original team list <u>CANNOT</u> be borrowed for Finals irrespective of how many times they have filled in
- We ask that when using a replacement player that you please bear in mind the calibre of the player and the Division they are playing in.

Registered players will have access to the Northern Beaches PCYC FB Players page on request – NB: this is a closed group and to be used solely for the purpose of teams seeking subs. Any misuse will result in being removed immediately from the page.

FORFEITS

The team forfeiting MUST notify the PCYC of their team's intent to forfeit by phoning 9196 9100 and speak to a staff member – please take their name. Further implications of forfeits include:

- Forfeiting a game carries a fee of **\$80.00** forfeit fee payable prior to the start of the next scheduled game
- A **\$100** forfeit fee <u>will</u> be applied should the forfeit call come within three (3) hours of the games start time payable prior to the start of the next scheduled game
- The team delegate of the team being forfeited to will be notified by email and is required to acknowledge receipt of the email notification
- Teams in later time slots may be contacted in relation to moving their game times forward

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- ALL participants MUST be a current PCYC Member
- NO CARD = NO ENTRY! Recommended taking a photo of the barcode on the card and stored in your phone in favourites or a preferred card storage app. \$5 replacement card.
- Unless essential, spectators are currently limited to 4 per team until further notice. They are to sign in via the QR code.
- Players are required to wait in the foyer until their allocated game time
- Teams to exit via the mesh doors nearest to the lifts
- You are required to participate in a sportsmanlike manner, with respect for the umpire and opposition at all times
- At no time can a player abuse, insult or criticise any umpire, opponent or staff member
- Umpires reserve the right to issue a 1 min penalty to any players not abiding by the rules of the competition
- Staff and officials reserve the right to remove any player/s not abiding by these conditions
- At no time will person/s on the sideline (ie supporters, players on the bench) address the umpire or player/s in an unsportsmanlike manner anyone see to be abusing players and/or officials on court will be asked to leave the premises immediately

GAME DURATION

45 minutes - 4 x 9 minute quarters, 1 min breaks, with running clock for all games.

CITIZENSH

SCORING

Teams listed <u>ABOVE</u> on the SportFix App (OR on the <u>LEFT HANDSIDE</u> on the scoresheet) are responsible for supplying a scorer 15 years and over for that match. Disputes concerning the score will not be entered in to if your team is unable to provide a suitable scorer.

STANDINGS – COMPETITION POINTS

Win = 3points Draw/BYE = 2 points Loss = 1 point Forfeit (Giving) = 0 point

FINALS SERIES

The formats for both netball competitions round are to be determined. Team delegates contacted directly once competition numbers are finalised.

UNIFORMS

- ALL participating teams MUST provide their own bibs
- Non-marking shoes *must* be worn at all times on the court
- PCYC Northern Beaches requires *all* jewellery removed however, we understand some items cannot. In this instance, it is the player's responsibility to provide tape. PCYC Northern Beaches notes players that choose to tape jewellery play at their own risk
- PCYC Northern Beaches allows taping of nails or gloves however prefer *all* players have their nails cut short. Again, it is the player's responsibility to provide tape and gloves.

RULES

Australia Netball Association Rules are played and adhered to by the accredited Umpires officiating

INJURIES

The player or team involved at the time of the incident, or immediately following the game must report all injuries. If injuries are not reported within 24 hours, PCYC will not be held liable.

We enc<mark>our</mark>age individuals and teams to bring their own tape as a precautionary measure as we do not sell tape on site.

BLOOD RULE (as per Rules of Netball - Netball Australia)

All blood stoppages will be 30 seconds, and the injured player must come off the court. If there is blood on bibs and/or clothing, it must be removed and replaced for safety and hygiene.

COMPLAINTS / CHALLENGES PROCEDURE

Teams wishing to lodge a complaint must do so in writing via email by the team Delegate. We request this is done within 3 working days. Any challenges made by a team towards another team or player e.g. suspected unregistered players playing or other match disputes, must be done through the competition staff as soon as possible; preferably during breaks or at the end of the game.

WARNINGS/SUSPENSIONS

In the event of three (3) accumulated warnings, suspension awarded at the discretion of PCYC management. NB suspensions can apply for all on/off court incidents at PCYC; you are responsible for your own actions and behaviour at all times. Team Delegates will be notified on the final decision via email. Suspensions are determined by Management and are final.

PREGNANCY

Player plays at own risk. We recommend participants seek guidance from their GP.
