Junior Basketball Competition Registration Pack

How to register your team:

- Team delegate (parent) jump onto [Sportfix: PCYC Port Macquarie](https://sportfix.net/PCYCPortMacquarie) at <https://sportfix.net/PCYCPortMacquarie> and register the team in the correct competition.
 - Team delegate must then share the link with every player that wishes to play on that team so they can register and pay the registration fee. **NOTE** – The team delegate also needs to register themselves.
 - Please note that **NO PLAYER WILL TAKE THE COURT UNTIL THEY HAVE PAID THEIR REGISTRATION FEE.**
 - Once all players are registered, fixtures will be allocated and visible online.
 - Team delegates are responsible for chasing up and ensuring all players register and pay.
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- ★ All players **MUST** be PCYC members before entering the PCYC. Junior membership is \$15 per year and can be completed on our website or in the club.
 - ★ All player details **MUST** be filled in upon registration. Only the players who appear on the team sheet and have paid their fees will be eligible to play.

SEASON DATES:

PCYC Port Macquarie's first competitions will be short competitions to begin with, moving into 20-week competitions over two school terms (skipping school holidays) in Term 3.

Junior Basketball Competitions will begin in Term 2 and run for 10 weeks including 2 weeks of finals.

PLAYER REGISTRATION FEES:

Junior fees are very low, with each player paying a player registration fee (roughly \$8-9 per game), with finals as a bonus. These payments go towards court hire, referees, equipment, and general administration fees. All fees are due before the first game of the competition.

TEAMS AND PLAYERS:

It is recommended to register at least 7 players to ensure the ability to field a full team each game. A maximum of 10 registered players is encouraged. The minimum age is 14 for Senior competitions.

TEAM DELEGATE:

As mentioned previously, the team delegate is responsible for ensuring all players have paid and registered before the due deadlines. The team delegate will be contacted in the case of any forfeits without correspondence. It is the team delegate's responsibility to pass on any correspondence to the rest of the team.

GAME RULES:

- PCYC Junior basketball competitions consist of 4 x 10 min quarters (excluding u12's which is 15 min halves). Forfeits count as a loss. 5 minutes of overtime in finals.

Win – 4 points

Loss – 0 points

Draw – 2 points

- In the case of a team being late, 2 points will be added to the on-time team per minute of lateness.

FINALS:

Basketball finals follow a 1v4 and 2v3 format for semifinals, with the winners of each respective game playing the next week in the grand final. **PLAYERS MUST PLAY AT LEAST 3 GAMES TO QUALIFY FOR THE FINALS.** Players cannot be borrowed for finals.
