## How To Register

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### **SPORTFIX**

Go to <https://sportfix.net/PCYCSouthernHighlands> to either Register a Team or Register as a Player in a team that has been created.

1. You will see options to Register a New Team or Join a Team – click register new team if you are creating a team or join new team if you have been given a team invitation code.
2. Team delegates when registering a team can send the players in the team the code that they will be provided once the team is registered. This is sent to them via email. So please ask your team delegate for the code to register.

**For the team delegates of the teams that have already registered, you can obtain the team code by logging into your Sportfix account:**

- Go to My Teams (from the profile icon in the top right)
- Locate the team you wish to manage
- Click on view team
- Click on team member registrations in the competition window towards the bottom of the screen
- The screen that appears shows you the code to send to players
- It also shows you who you have invited and who has registered

**You will need to create a Sportfix account, follow the prompts to do so when they appear.**

### **SPORTFIX FUNCTIONS**

**Team Delegates can now:**

1. Register your team
2. Obtain a code that you can now send to players, so they can go and register themselves
3. Manage your team moving forward including adding additional players and removing players who withdraw
4. Add additional Team Admins to assist in managing the team

**Players can now:**

1. Register themselves into a team, either from an email that is sent from the system when the Team Delegate adds them or by entering the code that the Team Delegate provides to them



## Competition Details

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### Player Competition Fees

**Season Fees:** \$110 per player includes match fees & individual player registration. All fees are due upon registering. Your team will not be added to the draw until there are at least 7 financial players.

\*Please note: No discount on fees will be given if a BYE exists and/or a forfeit occurs in your competition or division.

### Season Dates and Times

The Season kicks off for it's first week on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> October 2023.

**Timeslots: Between 6pm – 9pm**

\*Please note: Timeslots subject to demand and may change. Game times will be distributed as evenly as possible, however it is not always possible to get draws exactly even.

## Game and Competition Requirements

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### Team Captain, Manager, Coach or Parent

A Team Captain, Manager, Coach or Parent (i.e. Delegate) must be nominated on the team nomination form with complete contact details. In the event of a forfeit or any correspondence, the team delegate will be contacted by PCYC Southern Highlands. It will be the responsibility of the team delegate to pass all correspondence onto their team players.

### Team Registration

- Team Nomination Forms including ALL Player details must be completed upon registration for all competitions
- PCYC will NOT roll over nomination forms from previous seasons
- Only players who are listed on the team nomination form and have registered themselves on SportFix will be eligible to play
- Player are allowed to be borrowed during games if they can't field a full team.
- Team delegates are responsible for updating player details throughout the season



## **Duration of Games**

**ADULTS / JUNIORS:** 2 X 20 Minute halves, 3 Minute halftime, 5 Minute transition for next game

**6 VS 6 including goalkeeper with unlimited subs**

## **Teams and Players**

PCYC Southern Highlands recommend registering minimum 7 players per team with no maximum amount of players registered. **All teams MUST have a MINIMUM of 7 players registered** to be included in a competition.

## **Competition Rulings**

### **BORROWING PLAYERS**

A team may borrow registered players under the following circumstances:

1. If a team can't field enough players then players are allowed to be borrowed during games.

## **Disputes**

Any disputes from a team about another team, staff, or match officials, must be made with the competition staff as soon as possible. Any disputes need to be made at the start of the game or during so they can be dealt with and resolved at the time of occurrence if possible.

## **Complaints and Reportable Conduct Procedure**

Teams wanting to register a complaint or reportable misconduct about another player, team, match official or PCYC staff member / Tahmoor staff member will need to send an email to competition management within 24 hours of the event.

***PLEASE NOTE: This is the ONLY correct way of registering a complaint. Teams failing to comply with this and confronting match officials, players or staff may receive suspensions or dismissal from the competition.***

- A Goal Keeper may be borrowed for regular round games as long as the other team is happy for that to happen at the start of the game.
- Players can be borrowed any number of times throughout the regular rounds



## Uniforms

- All players in each team must wear matching jerseys / colours. Goal Keepers must wear a different coloured shirt to distinguish them from their team.
- All players must wear shin pads and long socks that cover the entire shin pad.

## Injuries

All injuries must be reported to PCYC staff / staff at Tahmoor at the time it occurs so we are able to record the injury. If the injury is not reported at the time of the incident, PCYC will not be held liable for the injury.

## **Competition Points, Penalties and Finals**

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### COMPETITION POINTS

Win = **3 points** | Draw = **2 points** | Loss = **1 point** | Forfeit = **0 points** |

PCYC Southern Highlands uses's FiXi Sports Management System, get the APP to see your results and standings available at the App store and Android.



### **SportFix**

Sportfix is a free app that offers a fun, fast and convenient way for players to stay up to date with their competitions. All data is published to the app by Sporting Centres using FiXi – The industry's leading Sports Management Software

## Forfeits

There will be no refunds for team fees paid when your team misses a game due to a forfeit. PCYC will do it's best to arrange a friendly game for teams forfeited against, however, please note this is not always possible.

Forfeits require as much notice as possible and **MUST** be made over the phone or in person with a **48 hour notice**.

Three registered players from your team are required to take the court to avoid a forfeit.
