



Making A Will and Information for Solicitors



We recommend you seek advice from a solicitor when drafting your Will. The wording is extremely important and your solicitor can advise you on the various types of gifts. It is also very important that you talk with family and loved ones about the decisions and wishes in your Will. Good communication will ensure Your final wishes are carried out.

If your Estate is not complicated you may prefer to create a Will yourself. PCYC NSW recommends you seek professional advice when creating a Will to ensure your Will is valid.

Perhaps you're updating your Will - if you already have a Will in place, the most cost-effective way to make a provision for PCYC NSW is by adding a codicil – a short legal amendment to your Will. Please check with your solicitors if a codicil is appropriate for the updates you wish to make.
