Important Reminders

- Included in this letter is the player's code of conduct. We ask players and parents to read to be aware of our shared responsibilities as members of Savannah Pride Basketball Club.
- Any monies owing from prior competitions and SP player registrations fees need to be up to date before we can register the player for the Winter Competition.
- Parent's participation in supporting their child's activities is very important as it builds a child's confidence and self-worth. It provides an environment where they can develop into a young adult that are socially aware of their environment.
- \$180 – Competition fee to be paid at PCYC Mt Druitt front desk in full before Competition starts. New players are to be registered with BNSW - \$100 for insurance online before playing.
- All players will follow age groups as per BNSW requirements.
- New players that have been with the club less than 6mths will need to be approved by Head Coach before they are deemed ready to play competition.

CODE OF CONDUCT AND COMPLIANCE RULES

Members are to be committed to the mission of Savannah Pride's program. All members must follow the following codes:

- Respect Coaches, PCYC staffs, Volunteers and team members
- Commitment to the team training and game's schedules, and wear your Savannah Pride's uniform.
- Communicate all the information to your parents or guardians and follow instructions.
- Those who don't listen to parents and coaches could be expelled from the basketball program
- If any player act in violence behaviour and indiscipline attitudes he/she will be suspended immediately
- All Junior and High School players must keep up their grades above average to continue in the basketball program
- All high school players who are on average or below school grades must attend a mandatory home work program that is organised by the club or your parents organised private tutoring.
- Any costs or fees set for the program must be paid on time

Not abuse or harass others

Do not abuse or harass members with action or words, or place them in danger, treat them in discriminatory way, or take advantage of them.

Respect privacy

Safety for all

Help PCYC and coaches to provide a safe environment and safe activities. If things are broken, let us know!

Report harm and abuse

Report any abuse or behaviours that put you or others at risk of harm to PCYC's staffs or coaches.

FOLLOW TEAM RULES AND POLICIES.

- All players must follow Savannah pride's training & team rules.
- Any argument or bad behaviour from a player toward coaches, referee, during games a player will be suspended for two weeks and will miss games; three times suspension will lead to player being suspended for one season (Six Months)
- Stealing or taking other people properties a player will be expelled completely in the team.
- All players must come to the training and games 15 minutes early. Any late player will face conditionings that are set out by coaches.
- Fighting in the game will not be tolerated and a player will face serious disciplines including suspension.
