Location: PCYC Auburn

Time: Every Wednesday, 7pm – 10pm

Duration: 22 weeks (across two school terms and July School Holiday)

Age Group: 16+ Men

How to Register

Registration Platform: Use FIXI for registrations before the first round.

- Team, Individual, or Group: You can register as a team or individual. New players looking for a team should email auburn@pcycnsw.org.au.
- Player Fee: \$212 for 22 weeks
- PCYC Membership: \$30/year, required for all players

Season Structure

- Games: Minimum of 22 games (20 rounds + 2 week finals)
- Points System: Win = 3 points, Draw = 1 points, Loss = 0 point
- Playoffs: Last 2 week for playoffs, determining 1st and 2nd place.
- Trophies & Medals: Awarded to champions & runners up.

Game Schedule

- Day & Time: Wednesday evenings, 7pm 10pm
- Game Duration: 2 x 20 min halves with a 2 min halftime break
- PCYC Auburn uses FIXI to manage game times, schedules, results, and ladders. All competition details are available on the free FIXI app.

Game Rules

- All players must scan their PCYC membership card at the front desk before entering the court.
- Players must write their number next to their name on the scoresheet before the games start.
- Teams lose 1 goal every 2 minutes they are late.
- If a team has less than 4 players, the game is a forfeit with a 6-0 score but can still be played as a friendly.
- If you can't make a game, contact the club, and we'll arrange a fill-in for your team.

Game Regulations

- The referee controls match time and stoppages.
- At least 4 players are needed to start a game.
- Direct and indirect free kicks apply.
- Goalkeepers cannot pick up deliberate back passes.
- A penalty kick is awarded for fouls inside the penalty area.
- Disciplinary Actions: Yellow and red cards are issued for misconduct.
- Fair Play: Players must respect referees and opponents at all times.

Game Format

- Finals: Teams not in semi-finals participate in placement games to determine standings.
- Players must play at least 7 regular season games to qualify for the semi-finals and finals.



SUSPENSION GUIDE

Offence	Suspension Period
1. Disputing decisions of a referee	1 week
2. Ejection	2 weeks
3. Using offensive, insulting, abusive language	2 weeks
4. Use of excessive force in a challenge/contest for the ball	2 weeks
5. Participating in the game whilst under suspension	4 weeks + suspension
6. Conduct that endangers the safety of an opponent or has potential to cause injury	4 weeks
7. Obscene language and/or Gestures (which may include abusive or insulting language or language that vilifies – comments regarding race, sexuality or religion)	8 weeks
8. Fighting	12 months
9. Threatening an official/Staff member/participant/spectator	12 months

Teams: Rules

- Players must pay the \$212 fee for 22 weeks before Week 1. No refunds for forfeits.
- Membership: Valid PCYC membership required.
- Team Size: Minimum of 6 players per team.
- Forfeits:
 - \$100 fee per forfeit,
 - Loss of 3 competition points,
 - No match points awarded.

Teams: Responsibilities

- Readiness: Teams must be ready for kick-off on time; late teams lose 1 goal for every 2 minutes.
- Fill-in Players: PCYC membership is required, except for those playing only once.



Teams: Uniforms Policy

- Compliance: Full and matching uniform from Week 1, and team colors must be the same.
- Team uniforms must have numbered singlets (0, 00, 1-99, no duplicates) and consistent team colors.
- Penalties: 1 goal penalty per player not in uniform.
- Local supplier contact info is available for teams to purchase uniforms.

- PCYC has free reversible bibs available to borrow.
- Goalkeeper must wear a different bright bib.

Teams: Code of Conduct for Players and Spectators

- Respect for all including PCYC staff, referees and officials, fair play, safety.
- Spectators: Respect for participants, supportive behavior, safety, no court interference, no direct engagement with players, no alcohol/substances.
- Do not use abusive, offensive, or disrespectful language or gestures during games.
- Fair play: Follow the rules and compete fairly. No cheating, harming others, or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Safety: Play safely and avoid risky actions.
- Breaking the Code of Conduct can lead to warnings, suspension, or removal from the competition.
